To be eligible for a scholarship under this program, you must meet the following requirements:

- * You are currently studying or intend to study nautical history, nautical archeology, naval architecture or wooden boat building, and you are or will be a candidate for a degree at an educational organization.
- * You are currently studying or intend to study at the undergraduate or trade school level.
- * You are currently studying or intend to study at an educational organization located within the United States and its territories.
- * You are a United States citizen or, if you are not a United States citizen, you comply with all United States laws regarding foreign nationals studying in the United States.
- * You will not have reached your twenty-fifth birthday during the year in which this application is made.
- * You submit a complete application and the documents required herein.
- * You are not a director, officer, agent or employee of The Nautical Research Guild, Inc., or its affiliates, you are not associated with the selection of scholarship recipients, and you are not a family member or a person living in their households of any of the aforementioned persons. Also, you are not a person who has made a donation to this scholarship program in this calendar year or a family member or person living in the household of such a donor.

You must submit the following documents:

1. This application;
2. A statement, written by you, describing your educational plans and any prior experience in nautical disciplines;
3. A written recommendation from a teacher who has taught you;
4. A written recommendation from a person within your nautical interest or activity or, if none, from another mentor of yours;
5. Your school transcripts from ninth grade (or your school's equivalent) to the present day or for the last four years of your academic study, whichever is shorter; and
6. Certificate(s) from your high school and, if any, post-secondary institution(s), showing that you are or were enrolled in good standing and that you have no uncured academic violations.


